## Background Pier 7 Berths A-D Fender Enhancements and Rehabilitation

#### Issue:

Increased cargo volume, larger vessel size, and ongoing deterioration of the fender system has required constant "band-aid" repairs.

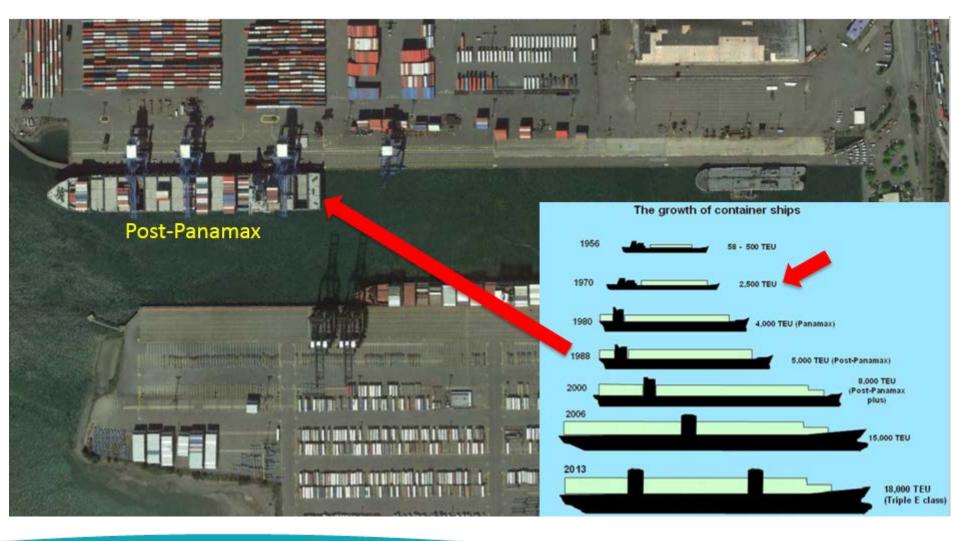
#### Reason:

  - Barge Dockings



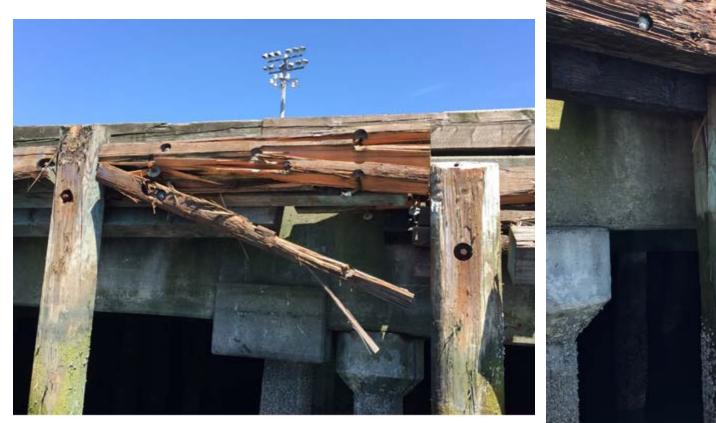

## Project Description and Details Pier 7 Berths A-D Fender Enhancements and Rehabilitation

### The scope of work will include:

- Removal of timber wales and chocks at berths A through C and a small section at berth D
- Timber pile replacement and fresh-heading
- Installation of approximately 1,900 feet (98 pieces) of steel waler
- Berth D replacement of remaining fabric wrapped piles (approximately 20 piles)
- Project and construction management
