- 100 ship owners, port authorities, terminals and shipyards in Canada and the United States
- Port program Port of Seattle, Port of San Diego, Port of Everett, Vancouver Fraser Port Authority, Washington State Ferries, Port of New Orleans, Port of Cleveland
- Compare with other ports share information and lessons
- Access to network and resources



Green Marine Program

- Self-evaluation annually, verified by third-party every 2 years
- Scores published publicly
- Seven performance indicators covering all port operations
- Scored Level 1 to 5
- Demonstrate continuous improvement
- Participants adopt practices and technologies that will have a direct impact on the ground
- NWSA joined in 2016, passed 3rd party verification in 2018
