## Strategic Plan Initiatives:

## B. BACKGROUND

Each year the Commission reviews and approves their assignments / volunteer participation on a variety of internal and external boards, work groups and associations. Some external groups and associations are open to all Commissioners (e.g. Chamber of Commerce, RAMP, Rotary, etc.) and do not require Commission approval. In addition, the list also includes roles that some Port of Tacoma Commissioners are serving in an appointed status (e.g. FMSIB, UWT Urban Studies Advisory Board) and do not require Commission approval. The primary objective of this Action Item is to focus on those Port of Tacoma and NWSA seats that require Commission approval.

The Commission received a briefing on the DRAFT Commission Boards and Work Groups at the December 19, 2023 meeting. Input received during that discussion has been incorporated into the final proposed Commission assignments presented here.
