

## RESOLUTION 2025-07-PT

### PORT OF TACOMA STRATEGIC PLAN 2026—2030

A **RESOLUTION** of the Port of Tacoma Commission regarding Port of Tacoma’s 2026-2030 Strategic Plan.

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Plan is to:

1. Create a roadmap for the next five years, laying out the Port’s goals in key priority areas, along with specific strategies to help us achieve these goals.
2. Determine the use of resources to maintain, improve, and grow our operations in a fiscally and environmentally responsible manner — key components of the Port’s business model as we continue to drive prosperity for our stakeholders and community.
3. Make strategic investments that enhance the Port’s infrastructure (waterways, terminals, roads, rail, industrial properties) that create the most efficient, productive, and cost-effective system possible to move our customers’ freight to the marketplace.
4. Provide strong fiscal stewardship of public funds, active marketing, and development of Port assets to promote business growth and jobs, environmental remediation of Port-owned properties, and building stronger relationships with our customers, partners, and the community.

**WHEREAS**, the Port received and thoughtfully considered input during the development of the Strategic Plan through several channels, including an online open house, our website, public meetings and direct stakeholder and staff engagement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port will create and utilize an Implementation Plan that promotes continuous momentum aligned with our mission aiming to achieve our vision and foundational goals of the Strategic Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Strategic Plan is a living document to be updated in 2030 and may be amended based on new information and continuous improvement as part of the Port’s annual budget process; and

**WHEREAS**, State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) review was undertaken, resulting in the issuance Determination of Non-significance Addendum on July 11, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port recognizes that as we work to reach our Strategic Plan goals through the implementation of a variety of strategies, ultimately, the key to this Plan’s success is through collaborative partnerships with our business, public agency, and community stakeholders; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the 2026–2030 Port of Tacoma Strategic Plan is adopted, as set forth in Exhibit “A” attached to this resolution and by this reference incorporated herein, for the purpose of establishing the future direction of the Port of Tacoma.

**ADOPTED** by a majority of the members of the Port of Tacoma Commission at a regular meeting held on **the 15th day of July 2025**, a majority of the members being present and voting on this resolution and signed by the Commission Officers in authentication of its passage this **15th day of July 2025**.
