Synopsis



- The Port entered an Agreed Order with Ecology in April 2022, to complete an updated Conceptual Site Model, Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, and submit a preliminary draft Cleanup Action Plan for the site.
- Ecology approved the Remedial Investigation Work Plan in May 2024. This authorization request will allow remedial investigation activities to proceed.



- The total estimated cost of the Remedial Investigation for this project is \$2,000,000.
- Settlements with former property owners total \$12.1M. This, less the PCB building demolition claim, and project costs to date, leaves approximately \$8.5M of the Settlement to complete the cleanup action plan and implement a remedy.
- Additional Commission authorization will be requested following completion of remedial investigations.
