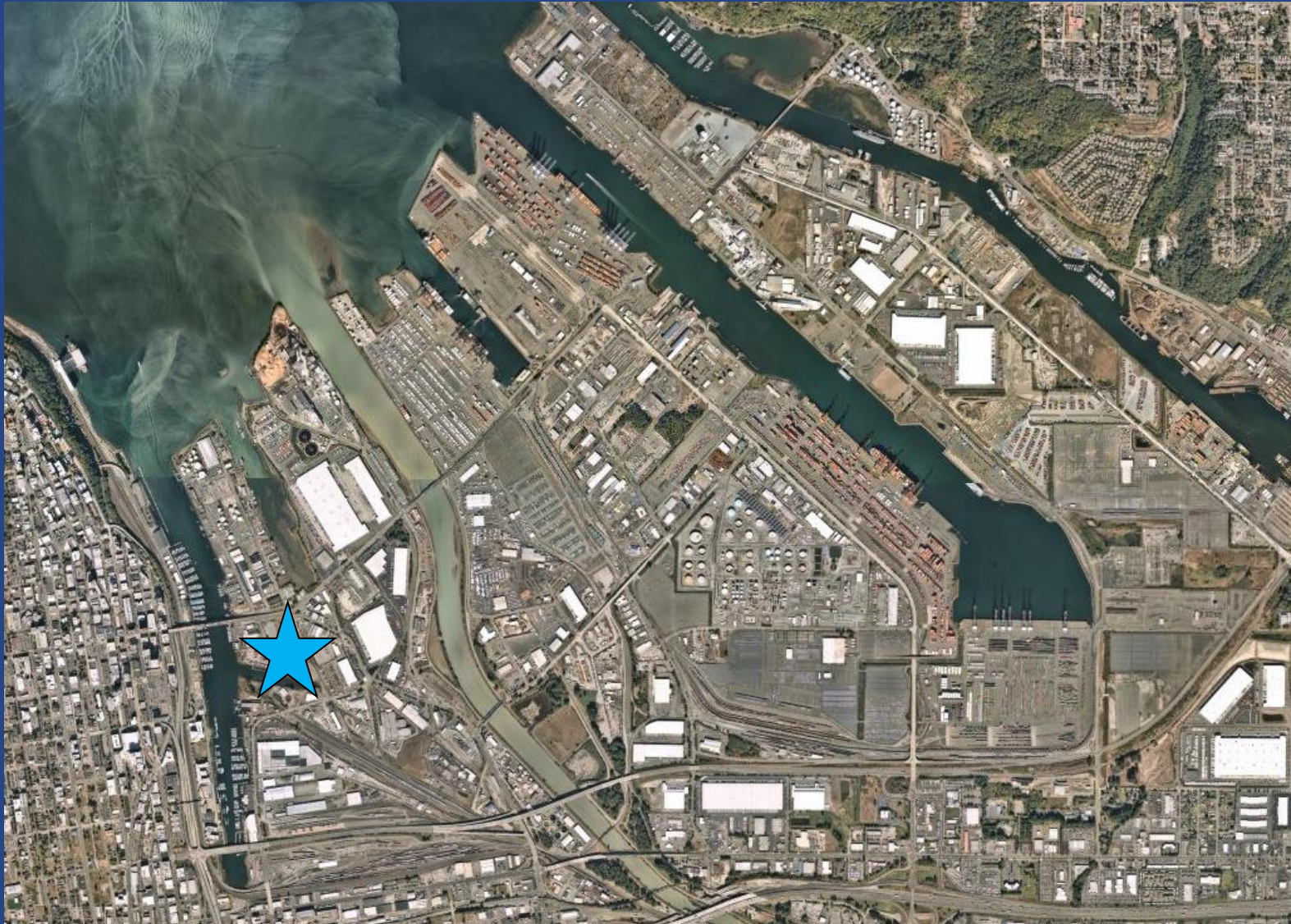

 - Economic and fiscal analyses

Grant Scope of Work



Investigation and cleanup planning activities are eligible under the terms of the grant. Planned activities include:

- Supplemental Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and cleanup planning at Parcel 92
- Supplemental Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and cleanup planning at Parcel 94
- Supplemental Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and cleanup planning at BNSF property, if accessible
- Community Engagement, Visioning, Cultural Resource Assessment and Master Plan for a Port Maritime Campus
