






PROGRAM SUCCESS

- Average person was homeless for 6.44 years prior to entering the program
- 44% of past participants are housed, employed and remain drug-free
- Participants earn an average of \$21.66/hour after leaving the program

PROGRAM CHALLENGES

- Drugs/addiction
- Mental health issues
- Violence
- Participants not wanting to change
- Entitlement



DEFINING SUCCESS

- What do we classify as "successful"
 - Housed
 - Have a job that supports lifestyle (most participants have a full-time job unless they are on SSI)
- Data
 - Cost per person
 - \$17,500/year (figuring 30 participants a year)
 - This figure includes our staffing cost and participant wages
 - Success rates
 - 44% of participants are successful
 - Most drop-outs happen because of drugs or violence



 - . Total individuals served: 309 people




The City of Fife collects data on homeless encampments within City limits. Through GIS, the location, needs and clean up efforts are tracked.
