Background

Extension of ILA between COT / POT



- The City of Tacoma and the Port of Tacoma entered into this ILA in 2013:
 - Direct result of an appeal of Surface Water Fees assessed to Port properties
 - Designed to create cooperation between the two MS4 permit holders (POT, COT)
 - New, lower surface water fee structure for
 - Wetlands
 - Water front properties

Background

Extension of ILA between COT / POT



- Benefits of the ILA include:
 - Joint inspections
 - Joint spill response
 - Courtesy review of Site Development Plans
 - Speeds up permit review for sites that don't discharge to City infrastructure

Project Description and Details

Extension of ILA between COT / POT



- This one-year extension request
 - Allows the POT to look at its response to the MS4 permit and
 - Work through changes with the City
- There are no current proposed changes to the ILA
- The amendment extends the time to September 30, 2019
