Background Parcel 103 Steam Plant Env Cleanup



- 1931 Site developed as Steam Plant
- 2007 Port purchased the property from Tacoma Power
- 2010 Preliminary environmental investigation
- 2012 to 2020 Dispute with Tacoma Power
 - 2015 to 2018 Cleanup investigation (project authorization March 2015)
 - 2018 Scope change from cleanup investigation to dispute resolution with Tacoma Power (Commission authorization April 2018)
 - 2020 Commission approval of settlement agreement with Tacoma Power. Key Terms: (1) Reimbursement of past costs (\$661,263), and
 (2) Tacoma Power to fund 84% of future project costs.
