1. Request authorization in the amount of \$210,000 for a total authorized amount of \$335,000 for work associated with the Stormwater Infrastructure Comprehensive Plan project, Master Identification No. 101636.01
2. Request authorization to enter into a grant agreement with the Pierce County Flood Control Zone District (Pierce County) for \$125,000 to create the Stormwater Infrastructure Comprehensive Plan.

- Pierce County Grant
 - Up to \$125,000 towards Stormwater Comprehensive Plan
 - Port Received Grant Award in December 2022
- Stormwater Comprehensive Plan
 - Confirm ownership, maintenance responsibilities in Tideflats
 - Develop strategic objectives for upcoming ILA negotiations
 - Prioritize infrastructure for repair or replacement over the next 10 years to protect assets from flooding events
